VILLAGE OF MARCELIN BYLAW NO. 01/2020

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS AND INSECTS WITH THE VILLAGE

The Council of the Village of Marcelin in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall herd, graze, or keep any horse, mule, donkey, sheep, goat, cattle, swine, rabbit, geese, chicken, pigeon, poultry or fowl, foxes, mink, skunks, fish or any other animal reared for the bearing of fur, feathers, hides, meat, milk, eggs or other product, or as breeding stock within the boundaries of the Village;
- 2. No person shall keep any bees or other biting or stinging insects within the boundaries of the Village;
- 3. This bylaw shall not apply to areas of the Village which are zoned AG Agriculture or FUD Future Urban Development;
- 4. Any person found guilty of an infractions of ths bylaw may be subject to the penalties set out in the Village's General Penalty Bylaw, Bylaw number 03/2000;
- 5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final approval of Council.
